

## WHY TURKEY?



- The Republic of Turkey is currently the 20th largest nominal gross domestic product (GDP) and 11th largest GDP based on purchasing power parity (PPP) globally.
- Turkey is among the world's leading producers of agricultural products, textiles, motor vehicles, transportation equipment, construction materials, consumer electronics and home appliances.
- Turkey Complies to European Standards(90% of Turkish exports are for European Market), so quality is high yet goods are reasonably priced- better than rest of Europe.
- Prices are cheaper than rest of Europe.
- Turkey offers a business-friendly environment, a deep talent pool and global market access at the nexus of Asia and Europe. Hence, the Turkish environment is very close to the properly functioning markets from the east and west.
- Currently 1 dollar (=19.9 Lira) can get you a lot more in Turkey (due to on-going inflation)



## WHY TURKEY?



- Some high demand exports to Turkey include Avocado-avocado is like Gold in turkey (read KEITT exporters Ltd who export to Turkey), Bananas (Turks Love Kenyan Bananas) and Pineapples.
- Turkey does not do differentiated product lines to target different income/quality segments- unlike China
- Big Industries in Turkey where customers can visit manufacturers and Industrial zones are:
  - FMCG-Turkey
  - Agricultural Machinery
  - Poultry equipment- Turkey is the 6<sup>th</sup> largest exporter of poultry equipment.
  - Textiles and apparels
  - Medical and Pharmaceuticals
  - Furniture
  - Chemicals and fertilizers
- Big summer sales in August- so you will experience good shopping at reasonable prices
- Leisure: This trip has a component of 20% leisure- you will be able to see the best sites in Turkey (e.g. Dinner at the World Famous Iskender Kebab); City Tours; Cruising on the Bosporus Strait (Bosphorus Strait is a natural strait and an internationally significant waterway located in Istanbul, Turkey. It forms part of the continental boundary between Asia and Europe.; Dinner while cruising on the Bosporus strait

#### Political Environment:

 Presidential Elections on-going now- to be done by May 28 Meaning there will be a new government in place shortly, wanting to enlist goodwill

- Connect us with the Turkish Exporters assembly (TİM)- The only umbrella body/organization of Turkish exporters, representing more than 103,000 exporters operating in 27 sectors registered under 61 Exporters' Associations (e.g medical exporters association, stationery exporters association, etc)

#### Arrange for B2B meetings

- We can request the Embassy to arrange B2B meetings with specific companies
- **Due Diligence**: Connect NCBA SME customers to the Embassy Trade Office for due diligence and verification of Turkish Companies (very important to avoid scams and conmanship)
- Support with the NCBA Gala Dinner in Turkey- Invite President of Turkish Exporters Association and Istanbul Chamber of Commerce; Invite Kenyan Ambassador to Turkey
- Visa Assistance- Provide documentation to embassy in good time; Embassy is at hand to help expedite process.

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#### ABOUT THE NCBA- STRATHMORE ENTRPRISE DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME

The course is hands-on, and participant-centered. Using locally developed business case studies, participants are engaged in discussions enabling them to develop problem-solving and good decision-making skills. It is a sixteen-week programme.

#### Q. Can I get a bank loan to finance this trip?

A. Yes

A. Istanbul, Bursa, Sakarya, Kocaeli and Bolu

#### Q. What is the cost of the trip?

A. USD 2,980 if sharing a room and USD 3,590 if in a single room

#### Q. How do I get a visa?

A. African Touch Safaris Ltd (ATS Travel), an NCBA Travel Partner, will assist with facilitation of the visa to Turkey. Ask your NCBA Relationship Manager or Branch Manager to share with you the visa requirements. You are required to appear in person to submit the application.
